272 STEP OF BATU CAVES & EXPERIENCE SCHOOL OF HARD KNOCK SESSIONS

Batu Caves is considered one of Kuala Lumpur's most frequented tourist attractions, this 100-year-old temple. Batu Caves holds the record for the world's tallest Lord Muruga Statue with the height of 130ft. You will also climb 272 steps to explore the cave and for a stunning view of the KL skyline. You may even spot silvered-leaf monkeys and birds.

The Royal Selangor brand was set up in 1885 by a pewter smith from China. This will be a fun and exciting experience to showcase your artistic talents and a good way to de-stress by hammering down your masterpiece pewter. This workshop will also test your patience, tenacity and creativity. Once completed, you will be given a certificate, an apron and your own carving masterpiece as souvenir to take back home with you.

RUMAH PENGHULU ABU SEMAN CURATED PROGRAMME WITH BATIK WORKSHOP



Start the day with Batik Painting Workshop. Experience how to create hand drawn batik from scratch. Learn how to sketch the design on a piece of plain cloth, wax, color, fix the colour and remove the wax by boiling.

Next, visit Rumah Penghulu Abu Seman is a meticulously-restored Malay house that is the highlight of a trip to Badan Warisan Malaysia (The Heritage Trust) in Kuala Lumpur. The house offers visitors a fascinating look back into the traditional way of life of Malaysians, and the story of the house is interesting in its own right. Built between 1910 and 1930, this headman's residence was originally located in Kampung Sungai Kechil, which is a small village in Mukim Bagan Samak, Kedah. It was then moved to KL by the Heritage of Malaysia Trust as part of its ongoing efforts in the preservation and conservation of the country's architectural heritage.
