The winner of the 2001 Rufford Award for International Conservation for his work to save the Asian elephant, Menon is the founder Executive Director and CEO of the Wildlife Trust of India as well as Senior Advisor to the International Fund for Animal Welfare.

Menon is the Chairperson of the IUCN SSC Asian Elephant Specialist Group since 2013 and a member of the Species Survival Commission of the IUCN, on the International Jury of the Future for Nature Awards, an advisor of the Marjan centre of Kings College, London and a Faculty of the Kerulos Centre, Oregon. He is a Member of Project Elephant Steering Committee, The Committee to revamp the National Wildlife Action Plan, CITES Advisory Committee as well as the Central Zoo Authority. He is a member of four State Advisory Boards for Wildlife and an Honorary Wildlife Warden of Delhi. He is also the author or editor of ten wildlife books including the recently published bestselling A Field Guide to Indian Mammals and scores of technical reports and more than 200 articles in various scientific and popular publications.
